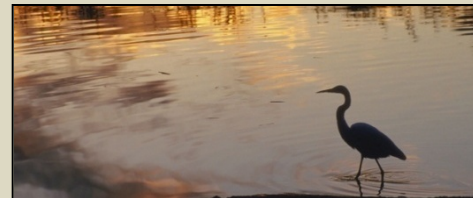
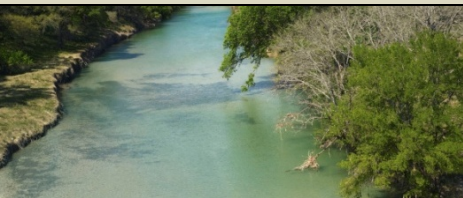
Texas Watershed Steward Program
