




What does the lesser prairie chicken "threatened" listing mean for me as a landowner?

This may be a question many landowners are asking since the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) announced in March 2014 that the lesser prairie chicken (Tympanuchus pallidicinctus) had been listed as "threatened" under the Endangered Species Act (ESA). "Threatened" means a species is likely to become endangered within

"Threatened" means a species is likely to become endangered within the foreseeable future. The 2013 population survey found almost a 50 percent reduction to a record low of 17,616 birds.


